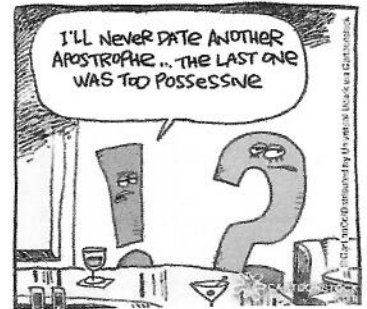


What's it like to be an aspiring writer?

He says "Give me a beer. Put it on my tab."

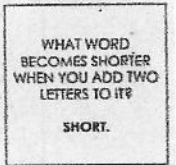


What dinosaur has the best vocabulary?

One should never mess with the apostrophe. It is either 'your dinner', or 'you're dinner'.

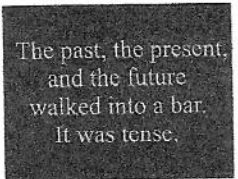
